## Example 15: E7b9 Arpeggio - A Minor Arpeggio

Example 15 consists of an open position E7b9 arpeggio which resolves to an A minor horizontal arpeggio. The fingering includes use of the third finger, but can also be played with two fingers as well. Django often used open position arpeggios.
